Günther Brück - born in Aachen, Germany - pianist, composer, arranger and producer, is one of the few European musicians whose compositions and arrangements can be found on various international CD compilations and are regularly broadcasted by radio stations in Europe, the United States and Latin America.

He has developed a music path that is rooted both in Jazz and in the Afro-Cuban/Caribbean traditions, enabling him to move confidently between the two genres.

Upon completing his jazz piano studies he moved to Cuba and on his return he directed the Salsa group "Sin Fronteras", to later join the Croatia-based Latin/Salsa band "Cubismo", giving hundreds of live concerts and TV Shows.

He has had important productions such as "Rumba for Vienna" and the most recent "Entre Amigos", adding as co-producer to the album "Renacer" by Alejandra Torres.

Throughout his career, he has been performing with artists like Mark Murphy, Sheila Jordan, Jay Clayton, Sal Nistico, Sandy Cressman, Michael Philip Mossman, Valery Ponomarev and several legendary musicians from the Afro-Caribbean scene such as Miguel "Anga" Díaz and Roberto and Luisito Quintero.

He currently lives in Austria and teaches jazz piano and leads the Latin Ensemble at the Arts University in Graz, Austria.
